

Voting Identification Requirements in Utah.

What you will be required to show.

- I. **Valid photo Identification which can be.**
 - a. Current Utah driver license.
 - b. Current ID card issued by the State of Utah or the Federal Government. (such as military ID or Civil Service ID)
 - c. Current Utah concealed weapon permit.
 - d. Current U.S. Passport.
 - e. A valid Tribal ID card. (Need not include a photograph.)

- II. **If you do not have one of these documents you may substitute two of the following forms that contain the voters name and evidence of residence in the voting precinct.**
 - a. Current utility bill dated within the last 90 days.
 - b. Bank account statement.
 - c. Certified birth certificate.
 - d. Valid Social Security Card.
 - e. Check issued by the State or Federal Government.
 - f. Payroll check.
 - g. Valid hunting or fishing license.
 - h. Certified naturalization documents. (not a green card)
 - i. Certified copy of court records
 - j. Bureau of Indian Affairs card.
